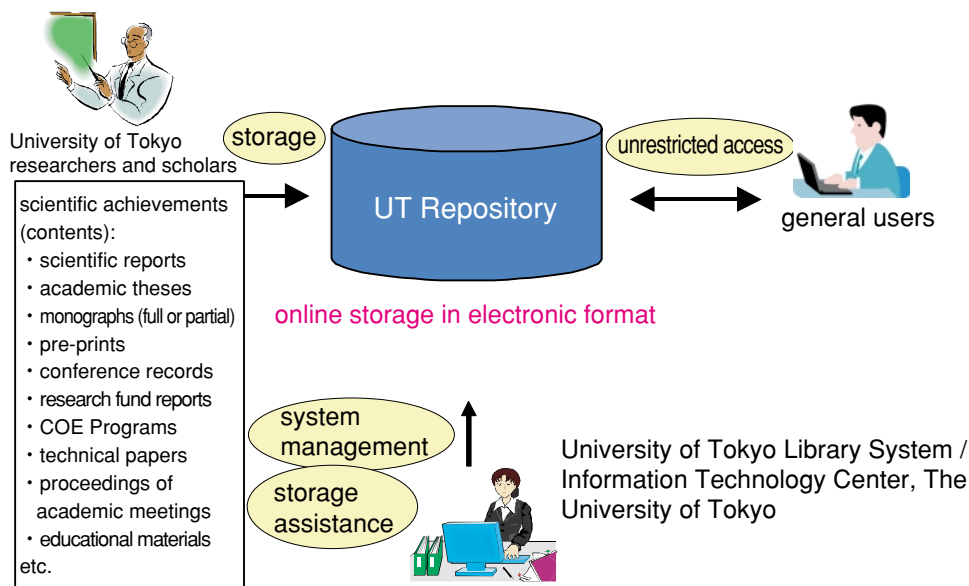


APPENDIX 1 : UT REPOSITORY

The UT Repository is a compilation of research outcomes produced by the University of Tokyo that is made publicly available in electronic format through a server connected to the Internet.

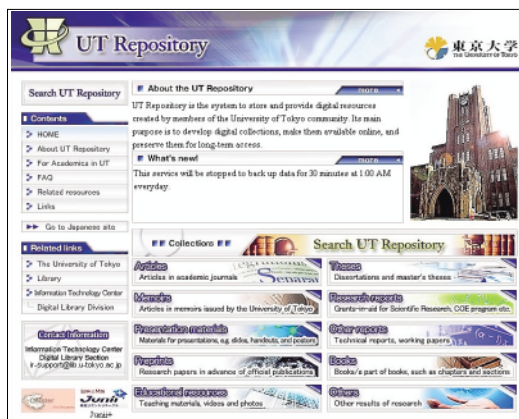
Research outcomes are traditionally published in a number of different ways, including through academic journals, theses, and academic proceedings. The concept of Institutional repositories, however, is now attracting considerable attention as a convenient and swift way to make academic achievements public.

The University of Tokyo library system and the Information Technology Center are collaborating with different faculties and departments to gather a variety of materials and store them in the UT Repository.

More than 1,000 Institutional repositories already exist throughout the world. The accumulation of data in the UT Repository is seen as an important project meant to contribute to the university's community and beyond.
