◆ Entering the library:

Please hold your ID card over the entrance gate.

◆ Borrowing: Present your ID card at the service desk.

• Books: 5 items / 2 weeks / 1 renewal

• Journals: 10 items / within the day / renewal not allowed.

→ Log in to MyOPAC to renew period or make reservation.

→ You can use also self-checkout machine at 4th floor.

◆ Returning:

Return books and journals to the service desk or drop them to the book drop in front of the entrance.

• Please do not drop large materials, audio visual materials (e.g. CDs), or fragile materials to the book drop.

• You cannot borrow, if you have overdue books.

• Books borrowed from other UTokyo libraries can be returned at the Science Library.

◆ Materials cannot be borrowed:

Rare books, reference books, and theses.

◆ Requesting books and copies (MyOPAC):

• Extend the loan period.

• Reserve on-loan books.

• Request items from other libraries.

(Delivery of copies, and delivery of books and copies from other universities are paid services.)

• Make a request for library purchase of the book.

◆ Copying:

• Card-operated photocopier (by public expense)

Members of School of Science whose department library is the Science Library can borrow copy card at the service desk. Please observe copyright laws.

• There are no coin-operated photocopiers.

◆ After hours use (only staff and graduate students of School of Science):

You can enter the library after regular service hours by your ID card or the University of Tokyo Library Card.

You can read open-shelf books and journals, and borrow them by using Automatic lending machine.

(Not available for maintenance: 23:00–26:30)

◆ Use of computers:

• PCs are available for searching e-journals etc.

Please login with School of Science network account.

• OPAC terminals are available for all users.

• Wireless internet access is available. Bring your own laptop.

◆ eBooks:

• “Springer eBooks Physics & Astronomy Collection” (about 6000 titles), “Graduate Studies in Mathematics (AMS)”, etc. are available. Search from E-journal & E-book Portal or TREE.



◆ Lounge:

• Drinks / conversation allowed.
