





Obtain research papers with TREE (UTokyo REsource Explorer)

TREE (UTokyo REsource Explorer) is useful when you want to search a document with a known title, such as a research paper in a reference list.



Please use electronic resources appropriately. In the event of unauthorized use, the University of Tokyo may suspend the use of such electronic resources.

- 1. The electronic resources are available to members of the University of Tokyo (faculty, staff, students, etc.) and those approved by the library.
- 2. It is prohibited to use the electronic resources for purposes other than personal academic research and education.
- 3. It is prohibited to transfer any information acquired using this service to third parties.
- 4. It is prohibited to download a large amount of data or to access excessively. Regardless of the full text file, it is prohibited to download a large amount of data and to access excessively regarding all information on contracted databases, whether it is done manually or automatically.
- 5. Disable the link read-ahead function of your browser or application before using it.
- 6. You may be required to use a unique ID and password to access specific databases. It is prohibited to share such ID and password with anyone other than members of the University of Tokyo.







