

A) Accessing within the institution's IP address

Step 1 – Within the institution's network, users will see "institution's name" displayed on the top right of the homepage

Step 2 – Users to click on REGISTER to signup for a personal profile

Registration is not compulsory but strongly recommended as it allows them to record the monographs they have viewed and earning the CME/CPD certificates, etc.
